CASE

The Borodino Museum employs a staff of more than 200 people and its computer network comprises approximately 50 workstations. In the future, the network is expected to expand to accommodate new users and workstations.

Museum employees spend most of their time collecting, cataloging and preserving items of cultural significance. Other important jobs include restoration of monuments large and small and public exhibition of the museum's collection. The Borodino Museum was awarded the UNESCO-sponsored Melina Mercouri International Prize for Safeguarding and Management of Cultural Landscapes.



PROBLEM

The museum's network of around 50 workstations is expected to expand to accommodate new users. The museum already has over 200 employees.

With an eye on future expansion plans, the museum needed a way to manage network security and traffic accounting while preventing access to undesirable websites.



SOLUTION



In 2013 the Borodino Museum decided to install a UTM gateway in order to get all of the network security functions it needed. The museum chose Traffic Inspector after thoroughly researching the cost and features of available UTM gateways. Traffic Inspector was deployed on a computer serving as the network gateway and immediately provided managed Internet access, traffic balancing and limiting tools, and extensive reporting features that empowered the museum's network administrators to study user traffic in new, better ways. In addition, now the museum's users only have access to those web resources that are directly related to their job duties.



The State Borodino War and History Museum and Reserve is located in the Mozhaisk district of the Moscow Region. It was founded in 1839 to commemorate the Battle of Borodino (the decisive battle in The War of 1812) and is the world's oldest battlefield museum.
